CORRECTED ORDER

Pursuant to its constitutional authority and powers of general superintendence over the New Hampshire Bar Association and its members, and pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 55 and 58, the New Hampshire Supreme Court assesses each dues-paying member of the association as of June 1, 2009, as follows, for the purpose of funding the Public Protection Fund (PPF) and the Lawyers Assistance Program (LAP).

Judicial	\$15	\$15	\$30
Active three years and under	\$15	\$15	\$30

Pro bono active	\$ 0	\$ 0	\$ 0

The members of the association exempted from the Public Protection Fund assessment by order dated July 22, 1998, are exempted from the assessments for both the PPF and the LAP. These assessments are due and payable on or before July 1, 2009. If the Board of Governors of the New Hampshire Bar Association grants a member's request for abatement of bar dues, it may grant a waiver of these assessments.

The New Hampshire Bar Association shall collect the assessments for the account of the Public Protection Fund and the Lawyers Assistance Program and shall report to the court on or before September 1, 2009, the

names of those members responsible for the assessments who have not fully paid.
