INTOXICATION

RSA 626:4 INTOXICATION

Evidence has been introduced that the defendant was under the influence of an intoxicating substance at the time of the crime. Intoxication is not itself a defense. However, if you find that the defendant was intoxicated you may consider whether this affected his/her ability to form the requisite mental state, in this case that he/she acted [purposely][knowingly].
