

**List of All Revisions to the DCSS S650, Child Support Guidelines Worksheet,
and 2010 Child Support Guidelines (Dated January 2011)**

DCSS s650, Child Support Guidelines Worksheet

- All references to "The maximum allowable monthly child care expense is \$416.66 for one child, \$750.00 for two children, and \$1,000 for three or more children." have been deleted.
- At Line "6E" below "Allowable child expenses (obligor)" the Guidelines worksheet now states, "See LINE 6E instructions on back."
- At Line "9A" below "Allowable child expenses (obligee)" the Guidelines worksheet now states, "See LINE 9A instructions on back."
- In keeping with HB1193, the worksheet's instructions on the form's back at "LINE 6E" now state, "Enter allowable work-related child care expenses paid by the Obligor in Column 1. Allowable work-related child care expenses means actual child care expenses for the children to whom the order applies, which are incurred as a result of the Obligor's employment, or due to the Obligor's participation in education or training activities associated with acquiring or maintaining work/job skills."
- In keeping with SB444, "LINE 6F" instructions now state, "Enter the actual amount paid by the Obligor for adding the children to whom the order applies to existing health insurance coverage, or the difference between individual and family coverage, in Column 1."
- In keeping with HB1193, "LINE 9A" instructions now state, "Enter allowable work-related child care expenses paid by the Obligee in Column 2. Allowable work-related child care expenses means actual child care expenses for the children to whom the order applies, which are incurred as a result of the Obligee's employment, or due to the Obligee's participation in education or training activities associated with acquiring or maintaining work/job skills."
- In keeping with SB444, "LINE 9B" instructions now state, "Enter the actual amount paid by the Obligee for adding the children to whom the order applies to existing health insurance coverage, or the difference between individual and family coverage, in Column 2."

Formerly Titled "2010 Child Support Guidelines," now titled "2010 Child Support Guidelines (Revised)"

- The 2010 CSG Booklet cover page formerly, "2010 Child Support Guidelines" now states "2010 Child Support Guidelines (Revised)."
- The DCSS s651, Child Support Guideline Calculation Table, in keeping with HB 1216, now publishes a self-support reserve of \$1,038.00 or 115 percent of the former self-support reserve amount of \$903.00.
- The Table's "Combined Adjusted Monthly Gross Income" now begins at \$1030 - \$1039.
- Lastly, Sections RSA 458-C:2 Definitions and RSA 458-C:3 of Chapter 458-C: Child Support Guidelines, have been updated to incorporate changes passed by HB1193, HB1216, & SB444.

Both the Worksheet and Booklet are dated "1/11" with a associated Division of Child Support Services Policy Release (DCSS PR) of "DCSS PR 10-12."
