This unofficial chart provides a quick glance at recently adopted and proposed rules for the NH courts. Throughout the year, the NH Supreme Court Advisory Committee on Rules (Rules Committee) considers proposed rules changes and any temporary rules entered by the NH Supreme Court. The Rules Committee considers all proposed and temporary rules and later schedules them for public hearing. After considering any public comments, the Rules Committee determines whether to forward a particular proposed or temporary rule to the NH Supreme Court with a recommendation. The Supreme Court allows for an additional comment period before making a final determination as to the adoption of a particular rule.

This chart attempts to clarify the status of a particular rule in the rule-making process. Due to the nature of the process, no timetable exists to determine when the Court will announce the adoption of a particular rule. The Supreme Court may also adopt a rule on a temporary basis. The Bar Association will attempt to keep this table updated as often as possible. We welcome your comments and suggestions.
