THE LAW CLERKS HAVE PRIMARY ASSIGNMENTS AT SUPERIOR COURT LOCATIONS IN MANCHESTER, BRENTWOOD, CONCORD, KEENE, DOVER, LACONIA, NASHUA AND HAVERHILL. IN ADDITION, ALL LAW CLERKS TRAVEL TO PROVIDE EXTRA COVERAGE AND TO ASSIST IN LANCASTER, NEWPORT AND OSSIPEE AS NEEDED.

NUMBER OF CLERKS: In general, there are fourteen (14) Law Clerks and one Law Clerk Supervisor serving the New Hampshire Superior Court. This interim vacancy represents one of the fourteen Law Clerk positions.

STARTING DATE AND LENGTH OF COMMITMENT: This interim judicial clerkship position begins as soon as possible and ends on August 20, 2020.

YEARLY SALARY: Starting at **\$54,678.00**; increasing to **\$57,388.50** on August 16, 2019.

BENEFITS:

From Interim Start Date Through August 15, 2019: 5 paid vacation days, 6 paid sick days, medical and dental benefits and paid holidays.

From August 16, 2019 Through August 20, 2020: 15 paid vacation days, 15 paid sick days, medical and dental benefits and paid holidays.

QUALIFICATIONS: J.D. Degree. Superior research and writing skills.

OTHER: Some travel to courts beyond the assigned court may be required.

TO APPLY FOR CLERKSHIP:

The New Hampshire Superior Court will accept applications for this interim Law Clerk position from now **through Wednesday, February 20, 2019**. Applications should include a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, a list of references and a writing sample of no more than ten pages in length.
