Eligibility Requirements: Nominees must be members of the New Hampshire Bar, or an organization employing eligible members, who at the time of the nomination, have at least five years of service, up to and including the time of the nomination, in government service, military service, law enforcement, public interest law services (including prosecution, public defense, legal advocacy in low-income communities or for individuals with disabilities at a nonprofit organization), or at an organization that is described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from taxation under section 501(a) of such Code.

Nomination Requirements: Nominations must be in writing, must demonstrate the eligibility of the nominee, and describe the criteria supporting the nomination with appropriate detail, ensuring that the descriptive *information links the nomination to at least one of the criteria set forth below.*

Previous Submissions: regardless of year, may be considered upon written request in a letter without having to resubmit qualifying criteria. Please include any updated achievements/information in the letter.

Criteria for the Award: The award recipient will be recognized for the individual's or the organization's exceptional *contributions and achievements in one or more of the following areas:*

- Outstanding commitment and service to the public as a public sector or public interest lawyer or organization;
- Outstanding legal contribution as a public sector or public interest lawyer or organization, which contribution can be in the area of advocacy, public policy, scholarly contributions, education or legislation;
- Outstanding mentorship contribution to public sector/public interest lawyers through sharing knowledge, experience, skill and commitments with students or other lawyers.

Additional Information Requested: Please list 3 additional people familiar with this nominee that may be contacted for further/additional information, one of whom must be an attorney.

If appropriate, please also indicate if you know of any reason why the nomination could not be carried over for consideration next year.

Nominations are reviewed and considered by the Public Sector/Public Interest Award Committee, comprised of members of the public sector/public interest legal community in New Hampshire, appointed by the NHBA Bar President and Bar Officers. The Committee of six contains a diverse representation of PS/PI practice, including the various sectors such as local, state and federal government, prosecution and defense, and public interest.
